



Invitation to seminar

Project to Help Young Immigrants with Gambling Addiction (MaPe) is a pilot project that offers support and rehabilitation to young problem gamblers and their loved ones. MaPe is excited to announce our next seminar, which takes place in Vaasa on May 15, 2008.

MaPe was launched in spring 2007. We have already organised two seminars, which were built around the themes of the various forms of problem coupled with their consequences among the young people and immigrant population. In the seminars we have also introduced the KBT rehabilitation model used in the project.

The May seminar is bilingual in Finnish and Swedish. Our guest speaker is psychologist Henrik Josephson from St göran's hospital in Stockholm, where he uses the KBT method in the treatment of young gambling addicts. There will also be a panel discussion between representatives of the authorised gambling providers (RAY, Veikkaus, Fintoto), rehabilitation workers, immigration workers and young people recovered from problem gambling through MaPe or other type of rehabilitation.

The detailed seminar programme will be send to everyone registering their interest.
